


Enabling Multi Factor Identification (MFA)

Organizations that want to add extra security for their members can activate the requirement to use MFA. From the main menu click on the organization initials icon in the top right hand corner and select 'manage my organization' You can enable MFA here:


Change multi-factor authentication requirement

Enabling multi-factor authentication (MFA) strengthens account security by requiring every member to provide a second verification factor when accessing the organization — for example a time-based one-time password (TOTP) from an authenticator app (such as **Google Authenticator** or **Microsoft Authenticator**). Once enabled, members will be prompted to register MFA, if not already registered, before accessing the organization. MFA helps protect against unauthorized access due to compromised credentials, such as through *phishing attacks*. We recommend enabling MFA to enhance the security of your organization and its resources.
